## Shared Process Improvement and Performance Excellence **RAPID IMPROVEMENT EFFORT**

Rapid Improvement Effort (RIE) enables you to identify a single area of concern that will benefit from a redesign resulting in rapid improvement. Small Kentucky districts such as Lee County found \$300,000 in savings from its RIE work. Examples RIE projects include salary structures, long-term facilities planning, operations, hiring quality people, budget development process, and transportation.

Presented in a 3-day, face-to-face setting, this workshop will provide a collaborative forum to learn about effective tools and techniques to enable your district to align around important initiatives, ensure effective use of resources, establish clear ownership of deliverables, appropriate resource and plan for change, and organize information management and flow.

The time between the first and second sessions will allow teams to complete the work they start at the workshop. Completing the work in their districts will allow teams to engage other critical stakeholders. Each district will be supported with virtual coaching, as needed.

An additional face-to-face meeting will be held to wrap up the work. It will include:

- a. Each district sharing their story board with the other districts
- b. Integrating feedback from other districts, if appropriate

# *Process Improvement and Performance Excellence*

## **FOCUSED ON STRATEGIC PLANNING**

Through master planning, this session provides districts with the framework to develop a strategic plan for setting direction, determining priorities for multiple years, simplifying the decision-making process, and bringing alignment to district improvement plans.

Presented in a 3-day, face-to-face setting, this session includes an overview and components of a strategic plan, establishing mission, vision, and values, and developing goals and objectives and strategies to achieve the goals. Thirty-three Kentucky school districts completed strategic plans using this process

During the time between the first and second sessions, teams will go back to their districts and begin the communication and engagement with stakeholders and community collecting input for the plan. Each district will be supported with virtual coaching, as needed.

Session 2 (day 3) will be held to wrap up the work. It will include:

- a. Review and Gallery Walk
- b. Linking Strategies to Processes
- c. Developing Communication and Engagement Plans
- d. Action Planning for the Strategic Plan
- e. Monitoring Plan for the Strategic Plan
